



CARE OF OUR YORKSHIRE GROWN FLOWERS

- Make sure the vessel used is clean
- If adding flower food follow instruction on the packet
- Metallic containers can cause oxidation.
- Remove any wrapping from the flowers and any foliage that would be below the water level
- Cut stems at an angle to improve hydration
- Place flowers in a cool place away from draughts and direct sunlight and heat sources such as radiators
- Top up water daily and recut stems every 2/3 days and replace in fresh water.

FOR YOUR SAFETY

- Handle flowers with care, some are poisonous,
- Lily pollen can stain and is toxic to cats.
- These flowers are display only and not to be eaten
- Handle flowers wearing gloves and wash hands before eating and drinking.
